A ROYAL INVITATION...

On Sunday 12th June, from 2-5pm, we will join the nation in celebrating The Queen's 90th Birthday. Our "Right Royal Knees Up" will be a street party, complete with afternoon tea and live music, open to all. We're hoping the entire community will come together to celebrate, at the same time raising money for Ravenscliffe@SpringHall. Tickets are £10 for adults and £7 for children.



WE'RE ON THE HOME STRAIGHT

With the required funds to build our new centre now secured, and the planning process well underway, we are now seeking the final £400,000 to fully equip to the highest standards. We are nearly at the finishing line of our campaign.

Through continued applications to grant making trusts, community events, the support of our corporate partners, and incredible efforts of individual sponsors (some of whom are featured in this newsletter), we are confident of reaching our target. In fact, we have already made significant in-roads into the £400k. We recently received £8,000 from Tesco, which could rise to £12,000, as part of their "Bags of Help" scheme, which saw revenue raised from the sale of plastic bags invested back in to the local community. This will be used to part-fund the adapted bikes storage and maintenance workshop at the new centre. We have also had preliminary discussions with a large local company about sponsoring our courtyard area, and money continues to come in from members of the local community.

Please allow us to offer our sincere thanks to everyone who has contributed, in any way, thus far. Our project has captured the imagination, and hearts, of countless individuals, organisations and charities. Without your support, we simply wouldn't be where we are today. Our campaign has generated in excess of £1,000,000 in just two years. We are now edging ever closer to realising our dream.
